The Distribution of the Light:

Your usher will bring the light of the Christ Candle to your pew. In passing the light to your neighbor, you celebrate the passing of the Good News through the centuries to our present time. In lighting the candles, only the unlighted candle should be tilted. Please exercise caution with your lighted candles. Young children with candles should be supervised closely. The candles may be extinguished after the Christmas Eve Prayer and Proclamation. Your partially burned candle is yours to keep if you wish or you may deposit it in the box at the entrance of the church as you leave.
